Doctolib announced today the launch of its public [Bug Bounty Program](#), developed in partnership with [YesWeHack](#). This program, which rewards security researchers who detect vulnerabilities, aims to constantly reinforce the robustness of Doctolib's infrastructure. Payouts have been doubled and can go up to 20,000€.

In an increasingly volatile, uncertain and complex world, cybersecurity is a key issue for companies. That's why Doctolib has always invested a lot to maintain a high level of security for both healthcare personnel and patients. In order to go even further in terms of cybersecurity, Doctolib announces the opening of its **bug bounty program to the public**, in partnership with [YesWeHack](#). The company has been running a private version of this program for several years and has decided to open it to researchers from all over the world to ensure that its infrastructure is at the cutting edge of security.

*"Doctolib's Bug Bounty Program is a great additional way to prevent security breaches. Who better than the greatest security researchers to detect them? By working closely with them, Doctolib gets ahead of potential intrusion attempts or vulnerabilities which might appear",* said Cédric Voisin, Doctolib's Chief Information & Security Officer.

With the opening to the public of its Bug Bounty Program, Doctolib now offers payouts up to 20,000 euros. The amount of the reward varies depending on the severity of the vulnerability reported and the quality of the report.

#### ***How does it work?***

1. The security researcher registers on [YesWeHack](#).
2. They compile as much technical information as possible and explain step by step how to reproduce the issue and to exploit the vulnerability.

3. Their report is then analyzed by Doctolib's security team and he gets feedback within 5 business days.

Doctolib and [YesWeHack](#) have co-organized "Hack me I'm Famous", an event which took place on April 13 and 14 at the Campus Cyber at La Défense near Paris, in partnership with BlaBlaCar and Malt.
